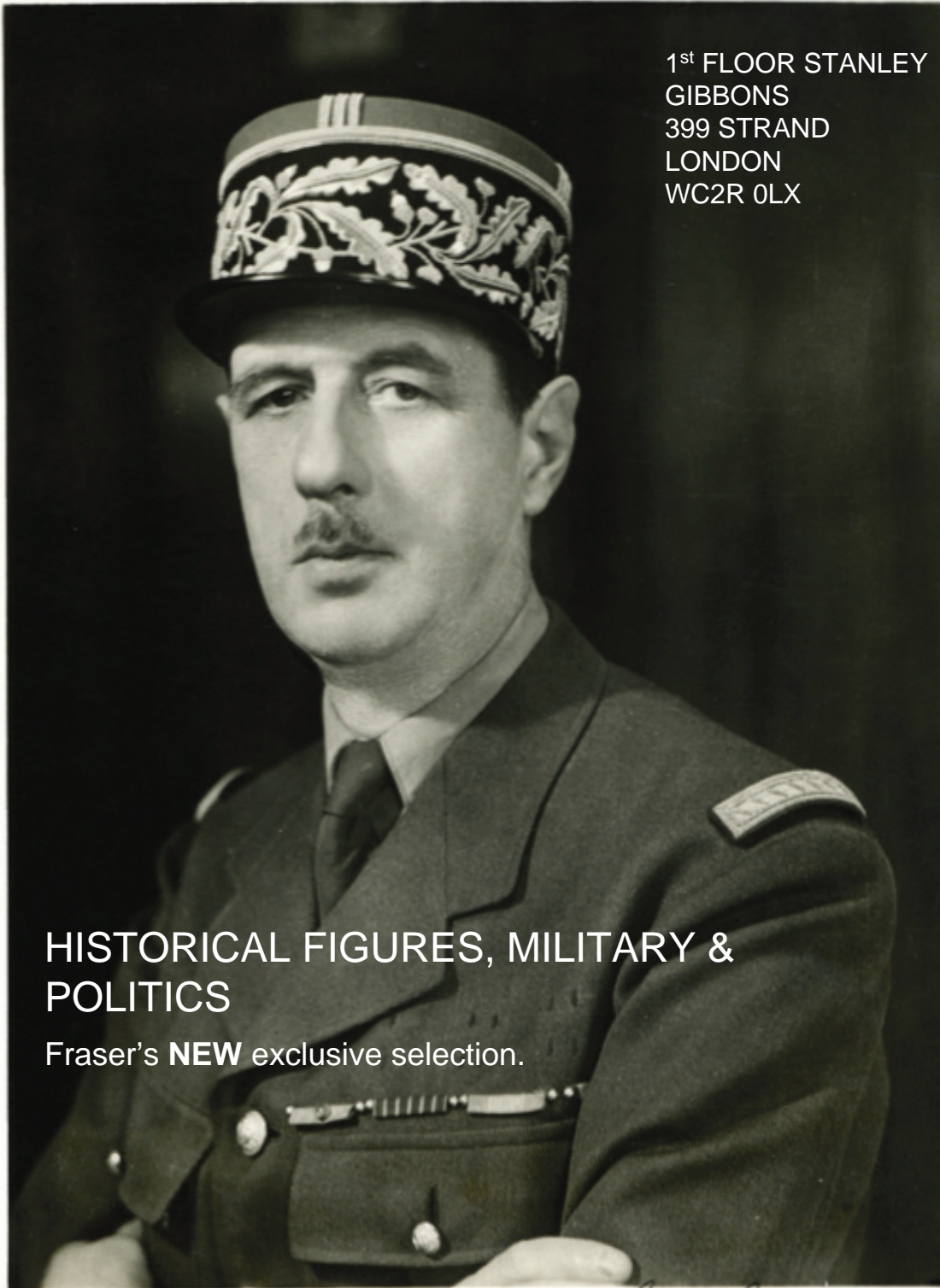

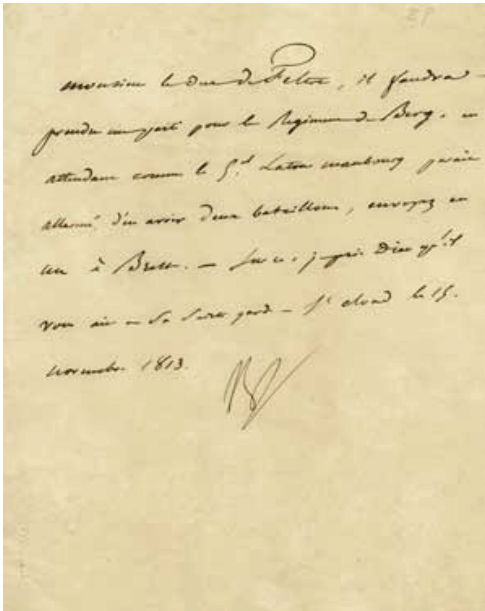

BONAPARTE, NAPOLEON

Military leader and emperor of France, dated November 19th 1813 and Addressed to Minister of War General Henri Clarke, Duc De Feltre. Translates as 'We will have to make a decision concerning the Berg Regiment, meanwhile as having two of its battalions seems to worry General Latour Maubourg, send one to Brest. On this I pray god to keep you under his divine protection.' This letter was written one month after the Battle of Nations, and other than a few pin hole marks in the lower left corner is in excellent condition. Item is written and signed clearly in dark ink.

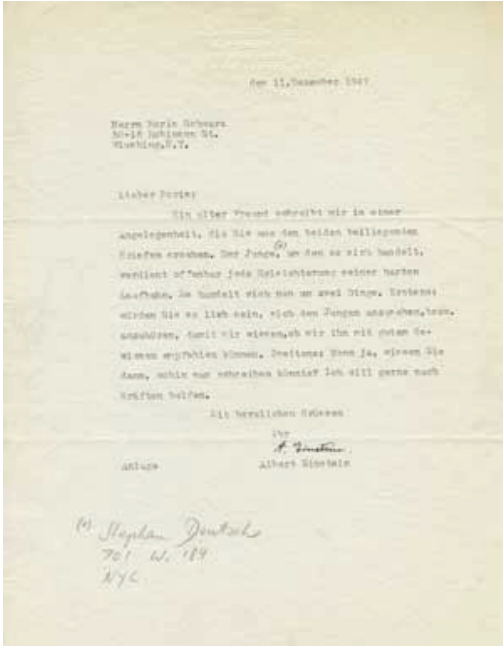
DE GAULLE, CHARLES

Wonderful signed photograph of the French officer and statesman (1890-1970). Photograph depicts De Gaulle attired in military uniform After entering the army in 1913, De Gaulle served with distinction in

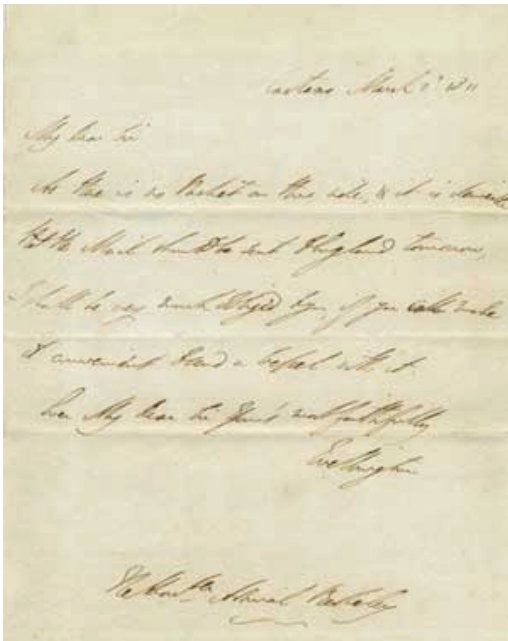
EINSTEIN, ALBERT 71730

Item is in excellent condition.



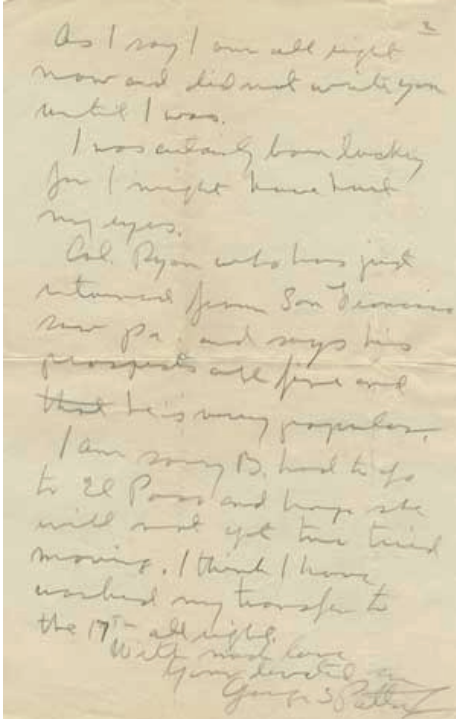
NELSON, VISCOUNT 71937

Highly esteemed British admiral (1758-1805) best known for his participation in the Napoleonic Wars, during which, in the Battle of Trafalgar, he lost his life. Small cream square of paper mounted to a piece of card signed by Nelson.



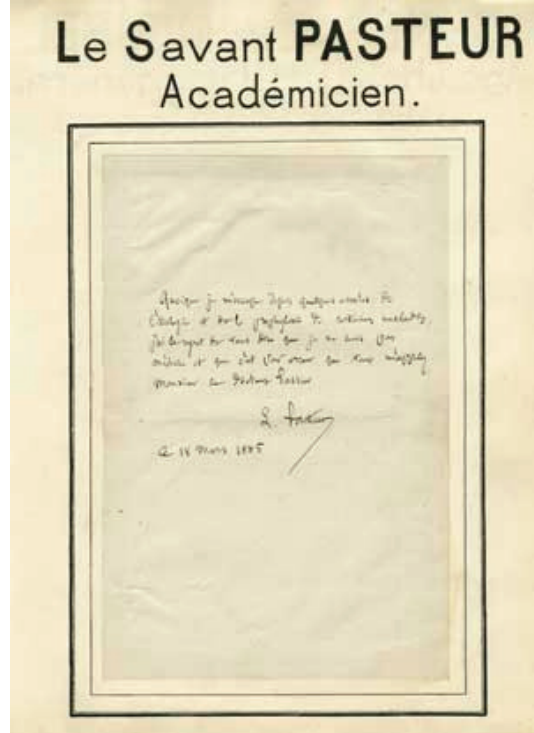
WELLINGTON, DUKE OF 71749

Fantastic hand written letter by Arthur Wellesley (Duke of Wellington). Field Marshal Arthur Wellesley, 1st Duke of Wellington, (1769 - 1852), was an Anglo-Irish soldier and statesman. He was one of the leading military and political figures of the nineteenth century. Other than fold lines, letter is in excellent condition.



PATTON, GEORGE S 71931

George S. Patton (1885-1945) Hand written and signed two page (one double sided) letter by the American army officer. Letter written in pencil, dated August 5th 1916 and addressed to Patton's mother Ruth Wilson Patton. Letter explains how Patton injured himself with a gasoline lamp. Item is in fine condition.



PASTEUR, LOUIS 71829

Chemist and biologist, famous for his germ theory and for the development of vaccines. Fantastic letter, written and signed clearly by Pasteur. Dated 18th March 1885, Letter is mounted to a large cream coloured presentation mount.



SMUTS, JAN CHRISTIAN 71830

A wonderful black and white signed photograph of the Boer statesman and Prime minister of South Africa. Photograph is mounted to stiff presentation sheet. Other than a small tear in the lower left corner, item is in fine condition.
